## Re: Year 1 Tower of London Trip – Friday 28<sup>th</sup> April 2023

On **Friday 28<sup>th</sup> April 2023** the children in Year 1 will be visiting the Tower of London in line with our history topic of Monarchs, roles and responsibilities.

We will be exploring the various exhibitions and the rich history at the Tower of London, linking these to our core history learning to understand how monarchs used their power in the past as compared to present day monarchs. The children will also be taking part in a workshop – Castle Life and there will be a cost of **£9.20 per child** to cover this, payable on the Arbor app.

We will be travelling on public transport and leaving school at **9:00am** promptly and returning by **3:30pm**, factoring in delays and other unforeseen circumstances.

Your child will need to bring a packed lunch to be eaten in one of the designated eateries in the Tower of London. In addition to a packed lunch, please provide your children with a bottle of water and any additional healthy snacks they may need for the journey and put all this into a comfortable bag that they can carry with them.

If your child is entitled to free school meals, a packed lunch can be provided on the day and this will need to be booked in advance with the teacher. Please make sure your child is wearing a full school uniform with a suitable coat and sensible shoes/trainers for this trip.

As this trip is in a public place, we would be very grateful for help from parents and carers to accompany the year group as additional adults. If you are available on the day, please let the class teacher, Mr Narh, know.

If you wish for your child to attend the trip to the Tower of London please give your permission on the Arbor app as soon as possible.
