Over the next few weeks and final half term, the children will be focusing upon 'Growing and Changing Me'. This will cover aspects of the RSHE curriculum such as: taking care of our body, how we change as we grow up, respecting privacy and our bodies, emotions as well as puberty and conception in upper Key Stage 2. Correct anatomical vocabulary will be used during sessions, as detailed on our website (<u>click</u> <u>here</u>) and in the RSHE policy.

Our RSHE scheme of work introduces language appropriate for the age of the children. It is important that children know the correct names for parts of their body as this increases a child's self-confidence and positive body image. We teach children that all parts of their body are important and no shame or stigma are attached to any part.
