Re: Year 6 Lamb Heart Dissection

This half term Year 6 are learning about the heart and circulatory system as part of their science curriculum. On Wednesday 24th September, the children will get the chance to dissect a lamb's heart.

In the past, children have found this session extremely beneficial and gained a greater depth of understanding of the organ and how it functions.

We understand, however, that there may be some children who will not feel comfortable with this, and so we will ensure that only children who want to take part in the activities do so. We will also take all the necessary safety precautions required, such as using plastic tweezers rather than scalpels, using good quality halal hearts and making sure that the children wear gloves and wash their hands thoroughly after the activity.
